Arguably the most successful of the works DB3S cars is chassis number DB3S/6, 62EMU, pictured below. Initially the car was built with a closed coupe coachwork unfortunately it crashed during the 1954 Le Mans race and the original body was destroyed. After being rebuilt for the 1955 season with open bodywork, the car came in 2nd at Le Mans.
