Bible Study Questions on the Book of Judges

Contents. Judges can be divided into three major sections: a double prologue (chapters 1:1-3:6), a main body (3:7-16:31), and a double epilogue (17-21).. Prologue. The book opens with the Israelites in the land that God has promised to them, but worshipping "foreign gods" instead of Yahweh, the God of Israel, and with the Canaanites still present everywhere.
