Identifying story elements: character, setting, problem...

Characters are usually people in a book but, in this case, a stuffed bear is a character, too. Sometimes characters can be talking animals. Think of the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Those bears are characters. A book tells a story about the characters and their problems and how or if they solve the problems.”
