Hirsch Jr. coined the term "cultural literacy" in 1987. He used the term to imply that just as literate people are fluent in reading and writing, culturally literate people should be fluent in their cultural heritages, histories, literature, art, politics and the like. Perhaps his most controversial work was a list of 5,000 facts pertaining to American heritage that Hirsch and his colleagues believed every American should know.
