El Niño typically lasts 9–12 months, and La Niña typically lasts 1–3 years. Both tend to develop during March–June, reach peak

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intensity during December-April, and then weaken during May-July. However, prolonged El Niño episodes have lasted 2 years, and even as long as 3-4 years.
