Only Epiobium hirsutum recorded 100% FI. Some of the most important medicinal plants with high FI values were Tribulus terrestris, Asparagus officinalis, Trifolium repens, Anemone biflora, Melia azedarach, A. absinthium, Lonicera quinquelocularis, Rosa webbiana, D. carota, Oxalis corniculata and Potentilla reptans.

Some of ethnomedicinal plants are also used as edible vegetables by the tribal people of the state. These wild medicinal edible plants constitute important traditional diets in the state of Arunachal Pradesh, India. About 153 such plant species or parts thereof are found to be used as food items.
