Referencing chapters in books. References to chapters in books should include the following: The author(s) of the chapter - by surname and initial(s) The title of the chapter; The author(s) or editor(s) of the book - by initial(s) and surname; The title of the book (in italics or bold) The edition other than the first (if applicable) The place of publication

Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

How to Cite a Book in APA Style | Formats & Examples

Harvard citations place basic source details in brackets, with additional detail saved for the reference list (see below). The details you'll need for a citation are the author's surname and a year of publication: A teacher's attitude can inform her classroom strategy (Mendler, 2012).

How to Reference a Book using the Harvard Referencing Style

More Tips for Book References in APA Format . Double-space. Remember that your reference page needs to be double-spaced. Indent. The first line of each reference should be flush left with the margin of the page. Each subsequent line of your reference should be indented. Use the DOI. If a digital object identifier (DOI) is available, include it at the end of the reference.

The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

Include the title of the piece; this could be the name of the book, the title of a journal article or webpage. Titles are usually written in italics. For books you should also include the edition (if not the first) to make finding information easier.

Further references to the Harry Potter books as a collection will be referred to as 'Harry Potter series (1997-2007)'. You can then use this short form in further references to refer to the series as a whole. How to cite a source quoted in another author's work (secondary referencing)

Reference with MHRA - Oxford Brookes University

Harvard Reference List Citations for Books with Two or More Authors When creating a citation that has more than one author, place the names in the order in which they appear on the source. Use the word "and" to separate the names. Last name, First initial. and Last name, First initial.

Continue your citation with the title of the novel, followed by a period. The title should appear in italics. List the city of publication, publisher, and the year published.

A reference list is a complete list of all the sources used when creating a piece of work. This list includes information about the sources like the author, date of publication, title of the source and more. A Harvard reference list must: Be on a separate sheet at the end of the document

### How to Cite Sources in Harvard Citation Format - Mendeley

Check the citation guide for the citation style you're using. They all have sections for citing visual images. Generally, you'll cite an image the same way you would a book, listing the artist or photographer's name, the title for the image, the year the image was published or produced, and where the original image is located.

A reference to a chapter in an edited book must include the author, date and title of the chapter, followed by the word "In", followed by a full reference for the book in which it's published, and finally the page numbers of the chapter.

Commas are used instead of periods between Publisher, Publication Date, and Pagination. Medium is no longer necessary. Containers are now a part of the MLA process. Commas should be used after container titles. DOIs should be used instead of URLs when available. Use the term "Accessed" instead of ...

Use this format when a person other than the original author has added a new part to the work, such as a foreword or... Provide the author of the whole book in the main author element of the reference. Then provide the name of the person... When citing the main book, include only the name of the ...

### Book References - APA Style

An e-book is considered a written work or composition that has been digitized and is readable through computers or e-readers (Kindles, iPads, nooks etc.). As of the APA 7th edition, a special notation does not need to be made for e-reader versions. Simply include the book's URL or DOI number at the end of the citation.

### How to Cite a Book in APA | EasyBib Citations

Note: When you list the pages of the chapter or essay in parentheses after the book title, use "pp." before the numbers: (pp. 1-21). This abbreviation, however, does not appear before the page numbers in periodical references. List any edition number in the same set of parentheses as the page numbers, separated by a comma: (2nd ed., pp. 66-72).
