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The value of the bond is often written as: $B_0 = \sum_{i=1}^{10} \frac{50}{1.08^i} + \frac{1000}{1.08^{10}} = \798.69 Which can be rewritten to use the present value of an ordinary annuity formula: $B_0 = \$50 \left(\frac{1 - \frac{1}{1.08^{10}}}{.08} \right) + \frac{\$1000}{1.08^{10}} = \$798.69$
