An abstract is usually around 150-300 words, but there's often a strict word limit, so make sure to check the requirements of the university or journal. In a dissertation or thesis, include the abstract on a separate page, after the title page and acknowledgements but before the table of contents.

Abstract Samples - Undergraduate Research

An abstract summarizes, usually in one paragraph of 300 words or less, the major aspects of the entire paper in a prescribed sequence that includes: 1) the overall purpose of the study and the research problem(s) you investigated; 2) the basic design of the study; 3) major findings or trends found as a result of your analysis; and, 4) a brief summary of your interpretations and conclusions.

## APA Abstract (2020) | Formatting, Length, and Keywords

This information is always included with the abstract instructions.

Introduction: This usually consists of several sentences outlining the question addressed by the research. Make the first sentence of the introduction as interesting and dramatic as possible. For example, "100,000 people each year die of...".

## Graphical abstract - Elsevier

The foundation of the reference is the same as for a journal article. If the abstract has a database accession number, place it in parentheses after the title. Note that you retrieved only the abstract by putting the words "Abstract from" and then the name of the abstract indexing database in square brackets.

## Journal article references - APA Style

TIP: Journals often set a maximum word count for Abstracts, often 250 words, and no citations. This is to ensure that the full Abstract appears in indexing services. Keywords are a tool to help indexers and search engines find relevant papers. If database search engines can find your journal manuscript, readers will be able to find it too.

## Title, Abstract and Keywords

For example, if you're writing about a study tracking owls at night, keywords could include "nocturnal," "predatory," and "flight pattern.". The vocabulary and terminology used in the Abstract should prepare readers for the topic and language of your full-length paper.

reviewers to judge the nature and significance of the topic, the adequacy of the investigative strategy, the nature of the results, and the conclusions. The abstract should summarize the substantive results of the work and not merely list topics to be discussed.
