Persistent poverty and unemployment have terrible consequences. One of them is malnutrition among children. The clinical effects of malnutrition are manifold: impaired pancreatic, liver, thyroid and immune functions; loss of liver function; respiratory and intestinal infections; and decreased cardiac output, decreased appetite, lethargy and long-term developmental effects.
