Roman Republic until the 1st century BC. An Oscan-speaking people,
the Samnites probably originated as an offshoot of the Sabines. The
Samnites formed a confederation, consisting of four tribes: the Hirpini,
Caudini, Caraceni, and Pentri. They allied with Rome against the
Gauls in 354 BC, but later became enemies of the Romans and were
soon involved in a series of
