Serpentine Swimming Club

Serpentinization is a geological low-temperature metamorphic process involving heat and water in which low- silica mafic and ultramafic rocks are oxidized (anaerobic oxidation of Fe 2+ by the protons of water leading to the formation of H 2) and hydrolyzed with water into serpentinite.
