

Social Cognitive Theory Paper

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The social learning theory emphasizes the importance of observing and modeling the behaviors, attitudes and emotional reactions of others. Thus it focuses on learning by observation and modeling. Social learning theory talks about how both environmental and cognitive factors interact to influence human learning and behavior.

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Discussed in this paper is one such psychological theory: Social Cognitive Theory (SCT). An account of the origin and key concepts of SCT is given, illustrated with examples from the broad range of subject domains to which it contributes. Thereafter a detailed analysis of SCT's contribution to Information Science research is presented.
