A loaded question is often a way of rhetorically making a statement, but it is grammatically a question. You will notice that as a logical fallacy it is in a category by itself, as can be seen in the Taxonomy of Logical Fallacies. This is because Loaded Question is a fallacy of questioning, as opposed to arguing.

Logical Fallacy: Loaded Question

Posing or raising a question mean that the question was "created", possibly implicitly, but is not necessarily directed to anyone in particular and does not necessarily require a reply. Since this is a research paper you should probably use raised or posed (unless Scientist et al. actually asked the question to someone, e.g. in a survey)
