In one of the most famous, but equally obscure passages in the Timaeus, Plato characterises time’s and the heavens’ coming into being as an “everlasting image moving according to number” (37d6–7). This is commonly understood as Plato’s most general characterisation of time.

The original story of the lost island of Atlantis comes to us from two Socratic dialogues called Timaeus and Critias, both written about 360 BCE by the Greek philosopher Plato.
